



What is a project?

A project is a single piece of work with:

- predefined start and end dates
- a clear specification of the objective or the scope of the work
- a pre-established **budget**, and
- a **timeline** that is dismantled when the project is completed.

Ref.- (James P. Lewis, 1995)









Key Issues



Innovation

Sufficiently novel in terms of the subject, technology, methodology, target group, etc.



Piloting

It must contain a testing component, which must be tested before being executed. This is the experimental part.



Transnationality

Problem with a Europe-wide presence, results that can be transferred to other countries.



Multiplier effect


A problem and solution that can be disseminated and replicated.
